NUAMES is a state funded public charter school and like a traditional high school, we accept all students who apply up to our capacity. We encourage you to apply early, because typically more students apply than our capacity allows and a lottery is needed to choose next year's incoming students. The first lottery drawing for students wanting to attend the Layton campus will take place on November 9, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. in the ballroom of building D3 of the WSU Davis campus. The lottery is random and you do not need to be present for the lottery.

Students who want to be entered into the November 9<sup>th</sup> lottery must have a completed application turned in to the NUAMES Main Office D-3 Room 316 by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, November 4, 2017. *Incomplete applications will not be entered into the lottery if you have questions please contact the school.*

Students who want to be entered into the November January 26<sup>th</sup> Ogden lottery must have a completed application turned in to the NUAMES Main Office D-3 Room 316 by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 20, 2018. *Incomplete applications will not be entered into the lottery if you have questions please contact the school.*

If we are not full after the first lottery, two more open houses will be held. If we are full after the first lotteries on November 9<sup>th</sup> and January 26<sup>th</sup> a waiting list will be compiled. ## ***Important Reasons to Consider NUAMES***

### **1. NUAMES, Academically, is one of the highest performing schools in the state of Utah.**

- Ranked in the nation's top high schools by US News and World Report.
